REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Please complete all required information. A separate form and a separate check must be submitted for **each club** and for **each child**. You may select as many clubs as you like.
- You may wish to select a second choice on the registration form. If your child is placed in the second choice club, you will be notified and the check for the first choice club will be destroyed.
- Make check(s) payable to “Central School PTA”. Write your child's name and selected club on each check.
- Please note that this year prices have increased to reflect the increase in the number of sessions being offered for each club.
- Registration is by **MAIL** only and must be mailed by Friday, December 11, 2009. Enrollment will be determined by the earliest postmark, therefore you must **MAIL** in your club choices as soon as possible. **NO** hand delivered applications will be accepted.
- **Absolutely no late applications will be considered. Please send in your form by the deadline!**
- Enrollment in all clubs is limited. Registration will be on a **first-come, first-served basis**. Do not promise your child a specific club. If not enough children sign up for a club, it may be canceled. **If your selection is not available, you will be notified and your check destroyed.**
- Neither Central School teachers nor club instructors are responsible for After School Club registration.

GUIDELINES – Please retain for your reference

START AND END DATES: Individual clubs may start and end of different dates. Please be sure to note the dates of the club sessions carefully.

TIME: Clubs will begin at 3:05 and end at 4:05 **except for Wednesday clubs which will begin at 2:35 and end at 3:35.**

REFUNDS: Refunds are only given if a club has been canceled. Please make your selection carefully as no other refunds will be given.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Full and partial scholarships are available to allow all children to participate in the After School Clubs program regardless of financial situation. Please notify Jackie Fonseca, (220-3420), as soon as possible if you are requesting a scholarship for your child. All requests will remain confidential.

ARRIVAL AT CLUBS: Parents of all children are encouraged to escort their children to their After School Club, especially at the beginning of the session. It is the responsibility of each parent and child to make sure each child arrives at the club. **Neither the PTA nor the teacher can be responsible for a child who does not report to an after school club.**

DISMISSAL FROM CLUBS: Children must be picked up **on time** from clubs. **A late fee may be charged if children are not picked up on time.** All pickups will be made from one door, near the LGI/flagpole. No children will be dismissed from any other location. **Drive through pickup will NOT be available.** **Caregivers MUST park and walk to the door of the school to pick up children.** If a parent/caregiver violates these rules, that child may be removed from a club with no refund.

WEATHER CANCELLATIONS/EMERGENCY PLANS: Clubs take place after school hours and are not part of the school district's curriculum. If school is in session but clubs are canceled due to weather or other reasons, you will be contacted (or a message left) at your residence. Please make sure to pick up your child directly after school in such a case.

FEES: The cost of each club includes all materials and a \$10.00 fee per child for the supervisor who takes attendance and dismisses children at the end of the clubs.

ALLERGIES: Please note that the PTA does not have the ability to control food substances brought in to Central School.

BEHAVIOR: Please remind your child that After School Clubs are a *privilege* and should be fun for everyone. All children are expected to behave appropriately in clubs. Any child who compromises the safety or enjoyment of the experience for others may be removed from a club with no refund.

INICIO Y FINALIZACION DE FECHAS: Cada club puede comenzar y empezar en diferentes días. Por favor estar seguro de tomar nota de las fechas en que cada club funciona cuidadosamente.

TARDANZAS A LOS CLUBES: Los niños tienen que ser recogidos a tiempo de los clubes. Todos los alumnos deben ser recogidos de la puerta cerca al LGI/bandera. Los alumnos no pueden ser recogidos de otro lugar en el colegio. Los conductores que recojan a los niños deben estacionarse y caminar hacia la puerta de la escuela para recoger a los alumnos. Si un padre o persona encarga de recoger a los niños viola las reglas, el niño podría ser retirado del club sin devolución del costo de tal club.
