The PTA is excited to bring the 2012 Chat Chess Program back to Chatsworth School! The class will begin the week of January 19th. It is an excellent 10 week program designed to teach your child about chess, or expand your child's existing chess knowledge. As last year, Alan Abrams and Mike Amori will be returning as chess instructors. They put on an outstanding program last winter and will be doing the same for this year. Alan is an experienced chess teacher who teaches at the Larchmont Library, the Chatsworth afterschool program and also privately. Alan's students have won 3 National Chess Championships. He is the author of the book, "The History of the World through Chess". He is a very talented teacher already a favorite amongst Chatsworth Students. Mike Amori is new to the Chatsworth School. He is a United States Chess Foundation Expert with 16 years of teaching experience. He was a former member of the American Stock Exchange and gave up a career in business to teach chess to children. Mike currently is an instructor at the Westchester Chess Academy as well as Rye Country Day School. Mike's passion for teaching is fueled by his strong belief that chess is an educational stepping stone for all children.

Chat chess will meet once a week during your child's lunch period. Each class will meet in a classroom. **If possible, Whitson's Lunch should not be ordered on your child's chess day.** Please do not bring nut or nut products for lunch on your child's chess day. If your child has ordered Wednesday Pizza, it will be brought to the chess room.
